Rent or downpayment on warehouse building to be purchased	\$58,000.00	First year rent on 4,000 square foot center projected to be \$57,600 or downpayment on purchase of similar size building would be \$58,000. These figures reflect what current going rates are beyond downtown Columbia. Currently we are in 1,600 square feet on Lady St and do not have a loading area for clothing pick-ups of Care Kits for foster children, the current space is not safe after hours, and there isn't enough room for a breakroom for staff & volunteers.
Proper shelving hanger racks and bins for sorting clothes; furniture for small breakroom & cabinets;	\$17,000.00	Larger space will require more storage and sorting equipment; we currently do not have a breakroom for volunteers and staff.

As our Mission Statement says..."is to provide support services and aid to meet the needs of children identified as at-risk or suffering from abandonment, abuse and/or neglect."
