Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

The South Carolina Network of Children's Advocacy Centers (SCNCAC) consists of 17 Primary and 12 Satellite Children's Advocacy Centers (CACs) located throughout the state and serving all 46 counties. CACs help abused children by providing forensic interviews and coordinating trauma-informed treatment response for those children. CACs reduce the trauma on children by eliminating the need for children to relive their trauma through multiple interviews with multidisciplinary team professionals while improving collaboration among all agencies involved in the child abuse response. In 2023, South Carolina CACs provided services to 13,413 child abuse victims. SCNCAC is the accredited state chapter of the National Children's Alliance and provides training, technical assistance, accreditation support, and statewide services to support the statewide response to child abuse in South Carolina. In Addition SCNCAC provides statewide protocol training and other assistance to multidisiplinary team partners, DSS and Law Enforcement agencies, to assist them in their investigative roles in the statewide response to child abuse. This funding will support the SCNCAC Guardify statewide forensic interview recording evidence management system that is used by CACs, Law Enforcement and DSS to protect the disclousures of children and enhance the statewide response to child abuse. The Guardify system supports the critical work done by Children's Advocacy Centers, Law Enforcement, and DSS in South Carolina by efficiently and securely protecting the distribution of forensic interviews to Multidisciplinary Team agencies. Guardify includes 13+ layers of cutting-edge cybersecurity to protect against unauthorized access. Additional information can be found at https://www.cac-sc.org/guardify/.
